LDCC Knockout Playing Regulations

The following interpretation of the 2017 Knockout Playing Regulations is drawn to your attention.

- 1. The start of the match may be delayed by up to one hour if there is bad weather. No overs will be lost. Overs will only be deducted if the start is delayed more than one hour.
- 2. Once the match has started, if there are interruptions for ground, weather or light, then the scheduled end of playing time may be extended for 30 minutes and overs will not be deducted subject to the scheduled time to finish the match being no later than 8.10pm (8.00pm in 3rd X1 KO matches).
- 3. The scheduled time for the end of either the first or second innings may be extended as a result of exceptional time allowances being allowed by the umpires. The umpires are jointly responsible for informing the fielding captain and the batsmen of any time allowances as and when they arise. Any such time allowances should be recorded on the Match Result Form by the umpires.
